


## OpenVpn Ip address change procedure

Step 1:

Make sure openvpn gui is running(icon in system tray lower left)



Right Click

Step 2:

hover over your connection and instead on clicking on connect click edit config

Step 3:

it opens notepad

```
# Are we connecting to a TCP or
# UDP server? Use the same setting as
# on the server.
;proto tcp
proto udp
```

Please change to correct IP Address  
Then exit and connect and enter mac  
password

```
# The hostname/IP and port of the server.
# You can have multiple remote entries
# to load balance between the servers.
;server 10.8.0.0 255.255.255.0
```

```
remote 50.187.163.76 34512
# remote 192.168.1.101 34512
```

Please make sure the  
line that you change  
does no have "#" at  
beginning

```
# Choose a random host from the remote
# list for load-balancing. Otherwise
# try hosts in the order specified.
;remote-random
```

Step 4:

Scroll down to line that say “ remote nnn.nnn.nnn.nnn 34512 ” (spaces are needed between remote and ip number and ip number and 34512

put proper ip number that was obtained from location([www.whatismyip.org](http://www.whatismyip.org)) at site that you want to connect to. Do not edit line that has hash mark at beginning “#”

Step 6:

Save file and then connect
